White and printed tablecloth based on PP nonwoven and floor covering made of polyvinylchloride, solid and embossed, based on yarns produced from polyester, with and without sewing thread produced from polyester as well as piping produced from cotton, polyester and polyester/cotton; partly finished with biological active products (also antifungal agents) accepted by OEKO-TEX®; produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Appendix 4, **product class IV** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Appendix 4 for decoration material.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
