is granted authorisation according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark, based on our test report **22.0.20158** 



for the following articles:

White, reactive and disperse dyed knitted fabrics produced from 100 % cotton, cotton/elastane, viscose/elastane, viscose (bamboo)/cotton/elastane, cotton/modal, cotton/modal/elastane, viscose/polyester, cotton/polyester, cotton/polyester/elastane (also neon pink, neon red, neon yellow) and mélange knitted fabrics produced from cotton/polyester, cotton/polyester/elastane, viscose/polyester/elastane and reactive printed knitted fabrics produced from 100 % cotton, cotton/elastane, 100 % viscose, viscose/elastane and cotton/polyester and digital reactive printed knitted fabrics produced from 100 % cotton, cotton/elastane, viscose/elastane, cotton/modal as well as pigment printed knitted fabrics (also neon pink) produced from cotton/elastane, cotton/polyester, cotton/polyester/elastane (also mélange); produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.

The certificate 13.HTR.24803 is valid until 31.07.2023
